**Bob Kelleman, Th. M., Ph. D.;** Dr. Kelleman is VP of Strategic Development and Academic Dean at Faith Bible Seminary in Lafayette, Indiana. Bob is also the founder and CEO of RPM Ministries, through which he speaks, writes, and consults on biblical counseling and Christian living. For 17 years, Bob was the founding chairman of and professor in the MA in Christian Counseling and Discipleship department at Capital Bible Seminary in Lanham, MD. Bob pastored for 15 years and equipped church-based biblical counselors in his pastoral ministries. Bob and his wife, Shirley, have been married for 38 years. They have two adult children, Josh and Marie, one daughter-in-law, Andi, and three granddaughters. Dr. Kelleman is the author of 18 books, including *Equipping Counselors for Your Church*, *Gospel-Centered Counseling*, *Gospel Conversations*, and *God's Healing for Life Losses: How to Find Hope When You're Hurting*.

Join us on May 10 - 11 as Dr. Bob Kelleman brings a wealth of Biblical insight and experience in caring for all kinds of people. During his time with us, Dr. Bob will bring us two sessions on **"How to Care Like Christ."** In these sessions we'll be challenged to enter into Gospel Conversations with people to help us help others face suffering in a way they know it's normal to hurt in this fallen world, but it's also possible to hope in Christ during that time. We'll expand upon that and also learn to help people by helping them acknowledge sin, but with the grace that it's wonderful to be forgiven, and it's supernatural to mature beyond our waywardness.

Dr. Kelleman will also present four sessions on the topics of **"God's Healing for Life Losses: How to Find Hope When You're Hurting."**

He'll talk about launching your grief journey with Christ, inviting God to join your grief journey, waiting with God on your journey of hope, and traveling with God in your journey of faith.

Dr. Kelleman will also present one session on counseling with unbelievers, using 1 Peter 3:15 as a basis for thinking through the question of "Can we do biblical counseling with unbelievers?"
